

Some things have been finished this year though...we've tackled the whole of Mark's gospel and met Jesus in the pages, we've delved into Revelation and also been shaped by some courageous and humble examples of the women in the bible in our Lent series.

We are the free, yours is the glory!" - Matt Redman



We took a 9 young people from our youth group along to the Diocesan May Camp for the first time in 20 years. It was an amazing and exhausting long weekend with all sorts of activities, seminars, teaching and worship. It was humbling to see hundreds of young people who are fired

up by their faith helping and encouraging each other in living for God.

CHRISTMAS & EASTER

During our Christmas services we focussed on the angel's love song from God to us and Easter saw us investigating a crime scene...had the body been stolen or did something miraculous happen?!



SUPPORT FOR UKRAINE

St. Andrew's were able to support Ukraine in various ways from collecting to running a Saturday morning hub to hosting families. We also looked at how & why both countries celebrate Christmas.



St. Andrew's hosted the Deanery Confirmation service this year and we saw 25 candidates confirmed by Bishop Will, 7 of whom were young people from our church.



We had some great youth confirmation prep sessions, joining up with St. Peter's Church, West Blatchington for teaching, games and bible study. It was a privilege to watch the young people explore and grow in their faith.

Pray that God will use them to do great things!










